If you wish to be considered for a scholarship, fill out the below application in its entirety and <u>submit it with all requested materials</u> to the Nassau County Women's Bar Foundation through one of the following means: (1) completed applications may be submitted by mail to the Nassau County Women's Bar Foundation, Inc., P.O. Box 395, Garden City, NY 11530; or (2) completed applications may be submitted by email to Lisa Fenech, President of the Nassau County Women's Bar Foundation, at lisafenech22@gmail.com. If submitting by email, all documents must be sent in one PDF document; multiple attachments will not be accepted. <u>Applications that do not include all necessary documents will not be considered.</u>

#### To qualify for the scholarship, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- 1) The applicant must be a resident of Nassau County.
- 2) The applicant must be a member of the Nassau County Women's Bar Association. Membership is free for law students. More information and how to join can be found here: http://nassauwomensbar.com/members.
- 3) The applicant must have been accepted to and currently enrolled in an accredited law school in Nassau, Suffolk, Queens, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Staten Island, Westchester, or Bronx Counties.
- 4) The applicant must have graduated college with a GPA of at least 3.0.
- 5) The applicant must have a GPA of at least 2.75 in law school at the time the scholarship application is submitted.
- 6) The applicant should maintain a GPA of at least 2.75 in law school for the year to which the scholarship funds are applied.
- 7) The applicant should display characteristics consistent with the mission of the Nassau County Women's Bar Foundation.
- 8) The applicant must demonstrate financial need.

# THE DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS IS FEBRUARY 21, 2025. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS AND APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER FEBRUARY 21, 2025 WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
