

SPRING 2025 HOLIDAY MAKE-UP SCHEDULE

According to the academic calendar, approved by the faculty, classes are not suspended on all holidays. Nonetheless, we know that many people (students and faculty) may be observing certain holidays.

In keeping with past practice, we have prepared a make-up schedule for only the EVE and FIRST day of select holidays. This schedule was created based on the spring holidays observed by the New York City Department of Education. Of particular interest to some may be the following holidays during spring 2025:

- Lunar New Year
 - Wednesday, January 29 – see the make-up schedule below

- Eid al-Fitr
 - Sunday, March 30 – **NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT**
 - Monday, March 31 – see the make-up schedule below

- Passover:
 - Saturday, April 12 (sundown) – **NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT**
 - Sunday, April 13 – **NO DIRECT CLASS IMPACT**

- Good Friday
 - Friday, April 18 – see the make-up schedule below

Note: No make-up schedule has been created for the holidays that have no direct impact on classes.

If you intend to cancel one or more classes in observance of the spring holidays for which there is a make-up schedule, please adhere to the following assigned days and times in which to make up your class. By strictly adhering to this fixed make-up calendar, it is possible to avoid make-up class conflicts for students that would otherwise occur.

For those who do not cancel class, consistent with the Law School's general policy, please record your spring 2025 class. Observant students will follow the normal practice of accessing the recording and watching the missed class at a later time.

If you plan to schedule a make-up class, please have your assistant reserve your currently scheduled room as soon as possible. Please keep in mind that the make-up class you schedule may meet for a shorter or longer time than the make-up block. **Please schedule your make-up class for the same number of minutes as the canceled class.**
